Seven members from The Lakeland Rotary Club, along with family members and friends recently returned from Honduras where they partnered with Honduras Compassion Partners in #TransformingLaPaz. The team built a wood house, installed water filters, constructed latrines, cooked and fed two neighborhoods, built a pila (water storage), painted the outside of an elementary school and refreshed an elementary school library. This library was originally funded by the FishHawk-Riverview Rotary Club. TLRC donated \$1000 to purchase 200 new books to add to the library after the team emptied and cleaned everything in the library. A team led by Ed Odom form FHRRC will be going to La Paz on 2.21.23. The Lakeland team collected school supplies and musical instruments that they took with them and donated in La Paz. They will be sharing their Honduras experience at The Lakeland Rotary Club meeting on Feb. 28th.

This week our District hosted 9 Rotarians from Peru – Rotary District 4455. It has been wonderful sharing with them the best of District 6890 and learning from them the projects their clubs are working on in their communities. These Rotarians are making an impact by supporting skills training for youth and young mothers so they can obtain jobs. They support projects that teach computer skills, sewing skills, and hair dressing skills to low income individuals. They also support programs to bring modern medical equipment to their clinics so they can provide better medical care. They will be leaving on Feb 19th and we are currently collecting hair dressing equipment for them to transport back to their county.
