What do Cycling, Running and Dancing have in common? They are all successful Rotary Fundraisers for a Cause.

- <u>Running for a Cause</u>: The Four Rotary Clubs in Lakeland recently hosted the Twilight 5K which benefits Common Ground Playground – a park where children of varying abilities can explore and discover with imaginative play experiences. The Lakeland Rotary Club, the Sunrise Rotary Club, the Lakeland South Rotary Club and the Lakeland Tigertown Rotary Club have worked together to support this park since its inception and proceeds from this annual race will be used to support the ongoing maintenance.
- <u>Cycling for a Cause</u>: The Tampa Midtown Rotary Club Presented \$22,000 to USF Autism Programs. These funds were raised at their 11th Annual Cycling for Autism event. These Rotarians have been passionate about supporting programs focused on helping individuals with autism and their families since 2009. USF will use the money for the Center for Autism & Related Disabilities (CARD), and the Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) educational programs.
- Dancing for a Cause: The Plant City Rotary Club recently used the proceeds from their Dancing with the Locals fundraiser to supply the Plant City Police Department with 52 life-saving AEDs worth \$92,000. These AEDs will be placed in each patrol vehicle. Their wildly successful fundraiser raised over \$125,000. The remaining money coupled with their wildly successful Wild Game Dinner will be used for scholarships and other local community projects.
