- Rotarians Easing Problems of Dementia (REPoD) Based in the United Kingdom, REPoD is a joint initiative between members of various Rotary Clubs who have recognized the need for increased support in the community for families affected by dementia.
- <u>Cure Alzheimer's Fund</u> is a non-profit organization dedicated to funding research with the highest probability of preventing, slowing or reversing Alzheimer's disease through venture-based philanthropy.
- Coins for Alzheimer's Research Trust (CART) The purpose of CART is to collect and provide funding for leading edge research for the cure/prevention of Alzheimer's disease (AD). This project has currently been adopted and funded by 22 Rotary Districts and various Rotary Clubs in North America.

- <u>Music Mends Minds (MMM)</u> is a nonprofit that creates musical support groups for patients with Alzheimer's, dementia, Parkinson's, traumatic brain injury, stroke, and PTSD.
- The Alzheimer's Association (AA) founded in 1980 by a group of family caregivers and individuals who recognized the need for an organization that would unite caregivers, provide support to those facing Alzheimer's and advance research into the disease.
