Do you have your World Polio Day programs and events planned yet?

As World Polio Day approaches, we need your help to amplify our message about eradicating polio to protect the world's children from a devastating disease.

We have made tremendous progress since the Global Polio Eradication Initiative was launched:

- A 99.9% reduction in cases of illness caused by wild poliovirus
- 3 billion children immunized
- 125 countries where polio was endemic reduced to two — Afghanistan and Pakistan — with the virus contained in just a few districts and provinces

But even just one case still represents one child's life forever changed by polio. That's why Rotary members must remain tenacious and keep our promise: We won't stop until we know that no child will ever again experience the paralyzing effects of polio.

Let's use World Polio Day to advocate for the support we need to make history by eradicating polio. Together, we end polio!

Polio Facts:

- Until we end polio forever, every child is at risk.
- There is no cure, but polio is preventable with a vaccine.
- We've reduced cases by 99.9% since 1988.
- World Polio Day (October 24) provides an opportunity to highlight global efforts toward a polio-free world and honor the tireless contributions of those on the frontlines in the fight to eradicate polio from every corner of the globe.
- World Polio Day is observed on October 24 every year to raise awareness for polio vaccination and eradication of polio. World Polio Day was established by Rotary International over a decade ago to commemorate the birth of Jonas Salk who led the first team to develop a vaccine against poliomyelitis.

Please try to have a Proclamation presented by your local government and come up with a program, fundraiser, or other event to increase awareness of what Rotary is trying to accomplish. Celebrate how far we have come and how close we are to the finish line!

Rotary Foundation Update:


