Civil War Memorial Sponsorship

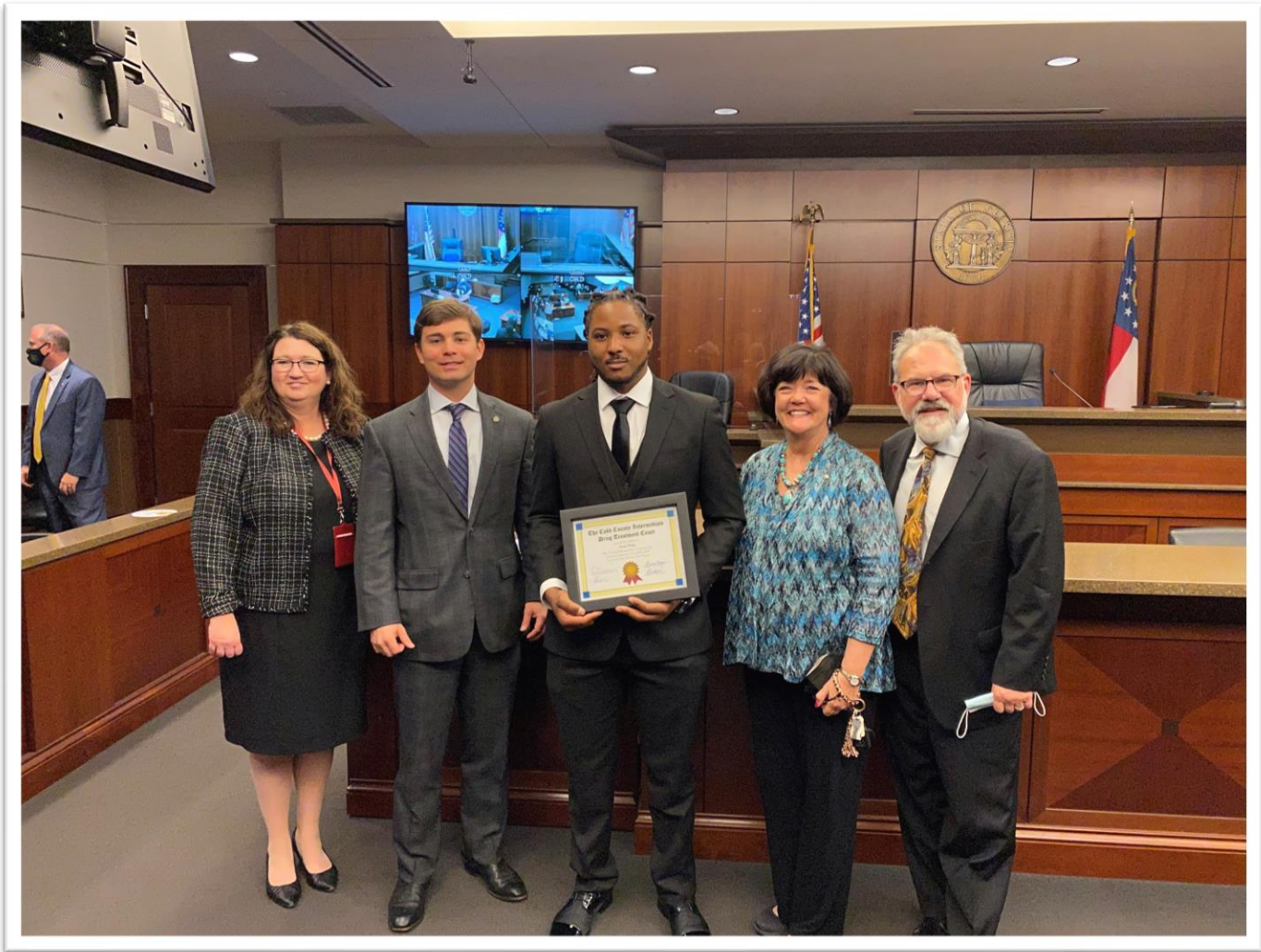
