Their responses, particularly in emergencies, have saved many lives and we are very fortunate to have outstanding individuals serving this city.

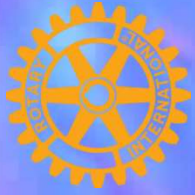

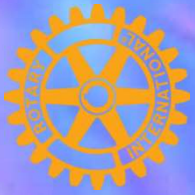
2022 -2023 Highlights
