

District Grant Application Steps – An Overview

District Grants for 2020-2021

1. Clubs will apply for a District Grant by using the DACdb Grant Module for 2020-2021.
2. *****If a club had a District Grant in the 2019-2020 year, the club must submit the Final Report to Joanne Tolleson by May 15th.
3. For the 2020-2021 year grant process the club must complete two qualifying actions:
 - a. The club President and President Elect must review and sign the Foundation Grant MOU.
 - b. Two club members must complete the 'Grant Management Training Course'. The course is available under the District Grant tab on the 6910 website. The 30-minute course is structured to be completed via computer from home or office.
4. Clubs can begin developing information needed for the grant application and assigning a minimum of 2 members with the responsibility to complete the training and apply for the matching grant.
5. Clubs will be limited to apply for one grant during 2020-2021 and the application cut-off date will be May 15th.
6. Grant application training will be shared with the Assistant Governor's January 31-February 1. The President Elects will receive the DACdb grant training during PETS February 28 – March 1. An e-learning grant application training course will be added to the 6910 website by February 1st.
7. The Final Report for the 2020-2021 grant will be due on May 15th of 2021.
