## DISTRICT 6910 GOVERNOR'S CITATION

DEADLINE: April 15, 2024

The purpose of District 6910 Governor's Citation is to provide a path towards a well-managed club and create a focus on Rotary International's Seven Areas of Focus. It can be used to help develop a strategic plan for your club to use throughout the year.

Clubs will have the opportunity for District 6910 recognition for achievement based on a point system. Clubs are responsible for reporting all information. The Awards Committee will collect data through Rotary.org and DACdb.

District 6910 Governor's Citation submission form will be active on the district website as of July 1, 2023. Form submissions will be accepted no later than 11:59 pm on April 15, 2024.

To achieve the Governor's Citation, a Club must:

- complete all Mandatory Objectives, and
- complete the Elective Objectives requirements (based on the club size) per Elective Categories in Leadership, Membership, Foundation, Service Projects, Public Image, and Youth Service.

The Elective Objectives Requirements:

- Small Clubs (1-29 members) must complete three (3) elective objectives.
- Medium Clubs (30-59 members) must complete four (4) elective objectives.
- Large Clubs (60-90 members) must complete five (5) elective objectives.
- X-Large Clubs (91+ members) must complete six (6) elective objectives.

Record your achievements to get the most points possible for the Club of the Year Award consideration. *Total points available: 137 points.*
