

## Tragically, Georgia Ranks Fifth in the Nation for Law Enforcement Deaths

- On average, one law enforcement officer is killed in the line of duty somewhere in the United States every 53 hours. Since the first known line-of-duty death in 1792, over 19,600 U.S. law enforcement officers have made the ultimate sacrifice.
- Following a two year decline, law enforcement fatalities in 2010 spiked to 162. This was an increase of nearly forty percent compared to the prior year, when 117 officers were killed in the line of duty.
- In Georgia the average age of the officers killed in 2010 was 38; the average length of their law enforcement service was nearly eight years, and on average each officer left behind two children.
- Georgia had nine fatalities in 2010, and ten in 2011.
- Care for Cops has provided financial assistance to over thirty-five families since 2004.

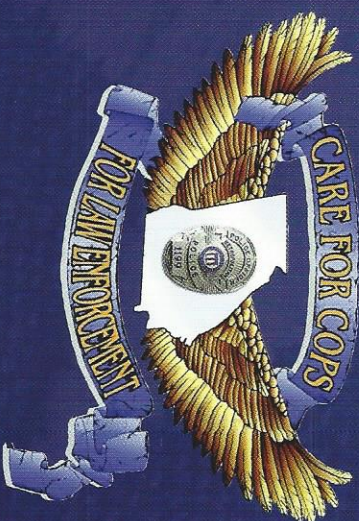

A motorcycle ride was planned and called Care For Cops Ride For Law Enforcement. After much hard work, the Care For Cops organization became a reality.

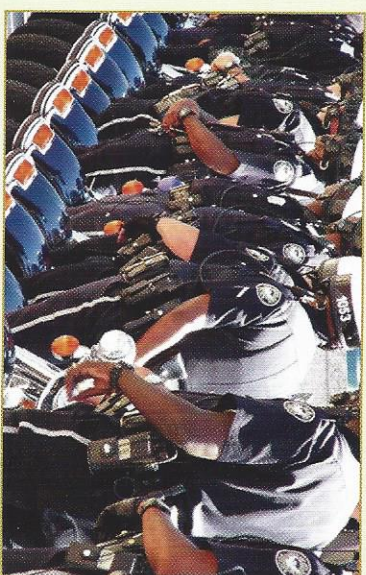
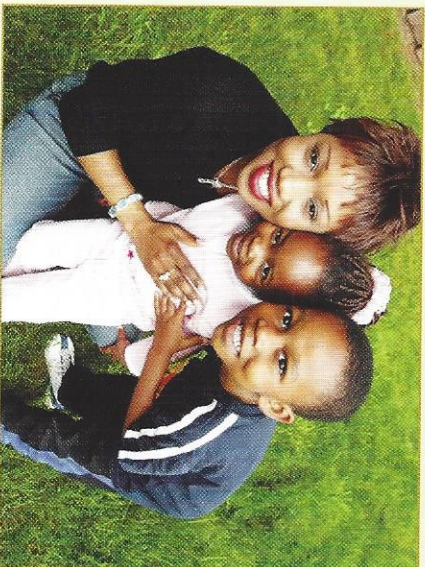

*Care For Cops is dedicated to assisting families of fallen law enforcement officers in the State of Georgia. We are determined to develop community awareness and good citizenship by recognizing those men and women who put their lives on the line for every one of us.*

In April of 2000, two hundred and fifty riders participated in the first Care For Cops Charity Motorcycle Ride. In 2003, Care For Cops was able to distribute the first funds to families of fallen officers, and in 2005 the organization received its 501(c)3 non-profit status.

In 2006, Care For Cops organized its first charity Golf Classic at Chateau Élan in Braselton, Georgia. The tournament was an overwhelming success and is now held annually at one of Georgia's most magnificent golf courses.



Since 2000, Care For Cops has received the support of over one thousand individuals, and has distributed tens of thousands in funds to deserving families.
