

Fun Facts about the Rotary Club of Sugarloaf

- ❖ Our club was chartered on September 17, 1982.
- ❖ We were originally the Rotary Club of South Gwinnett and then rebranded to the Rotary Club of Sugarloaf on February 27, 2018.
- ❖ Weekly meetings were originally held at Summit Chase; then Western Sizzler in Snellville; then Little Gardens in Lilburn; then Northwood Country Club; then The 1818 Club; and currently at Sugarloaf Country Club.
- ❖ We were the 2nd club chartered by the Gwinnett club (1st was Peachtree Corners) and 3rd club in Gwinnett.
- ❖ Main people from the Gwinnett Club that were responsible for chartering us were Elliott Brack, Buck Lindsey and Jim Steele (who was their club president at the time).
- ❖ We helped charter the Snellville club (now Sunrise) and all of their charter members were from our club except one.
- ❖ We were the first club in Gwinnett County to admit women. The first woman admitted was Carolyn Collins, who later transferred to the Peachtree Corners club.
- ❖ Our signature fundraiser, the Gwinnett Duck Derby, started in 2015 and has raised more than \$100,000 to benefit charities throughout Gwinnett.
