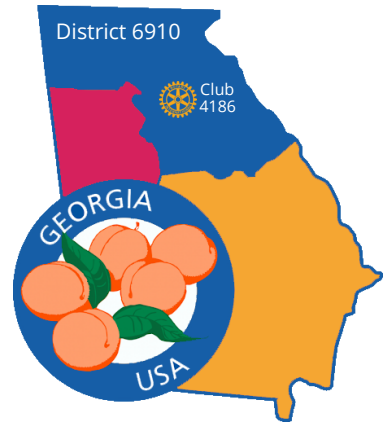

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

*What types of memberships are available?*

An **Active** Membership is for an individual. A **Corporate Membership** is for a corporate entity or organization. This type of membership enables more than one person from the organization to attend meetings, events, and service projects. Voting and other rights apply to the primary corporate member only. Other corporate members are referred to as Corporate Associate members.

*How are you connected to Rotary International?*

Rotary International is divided into zones, each made up of several Districts. Within each District, there are Individual Clubs that function autonomously. Along with Florida, The Bahamas, and others, we are in Zone 34. Our District in north Georgia, United States, is 6910.

*What is expected of me?*

As a club member, you will pay club dues, attend meetings, events, and service projects, and use your professional skills and talents to make a positive difference in your local community and the world.

*How much does it cost?*

Dues are assessed quarterly. Please see the dues breakdown below.

*How often am I expected to attend weekly meetings?*

Rotary International only expects 50% attendance. However, many Rotarians are proud of their 100% attendance. Increasing your attendance is easy! Each service project you participate in counts in your attendance. You can make up a meeting online, or attend a regular meeting of another Rotary Club. You'll find you have friends wherever you go!

*How do I become a member?*

A member of this Rotary Club sponsors an application based on your personal reputation in business, the community, and your passion for service. The Board of Directors approves the application and all Club members vote on your membership.
