The Rotary Club of Hall County (RCHC) is looking for a few good men and women to further our mission in Gainesville/Hall County. You know as well as I the importance of Rotary and what we can do together in our community. The Rotary Club of Hall County, affectionately known as the ***“Little Club with a BIG Heart”*** continues to focus strongly in many areas including:

Education: RCHC is a Partner in Education with both Sugar Hill Elementary School and New Holland Leadership Academy.

Community: Partnering with all 3 Hall County Rotary Clubs in 2016, our club led the over \$100,000.00 project to honor our Public Safety community with a tribute located in Roosevelt Square. We plan to revitalize this project to allow others to add a tribute to a deserving public servant by purchasing a brick for the sidewalk surrounding this beautiful water feature.

Veterans: We are kicking off a special project this year (2023-2024) for which we have received support and blessings from the City and the Veteran Community at large. Working with local veterans who maintain the Rock Creek Veterans Park in downtown Gainesville, we will be honoring both active duty and deceased members of the military by placing markers for individual service men and women twice each year in perpetuity.

I have attached a list of monthly projects that we accomplished this past year to help our community with smaller, yet relevant projects.

We would very much like for someone from your organization to join our Club and become a vital member of the Rotary Club of Hall County.

We offer two types of membership;

1) Individual Membership – Annual Cost of \$1,157.68 per year / \$289.68 quarter (includes all dues, meals, and program contributions)

2) Corporate Member – one voting member with an associate member. They can either take turns attending the meeting or attend together. The only difference is the meal cost when both attend (billed in arrears). We feel this membership is key to businesses that like to share in team work and have unpredictable schedules.

Concerned about Attendance? Rotary no longer requires 100% attendance so you would not need to make up missed meetings; but, we do want our members to be engaged and get the most out of membership, so attendance is key to leadership development and supporting our Club's mission of service.
