Objectives of EarlyAct



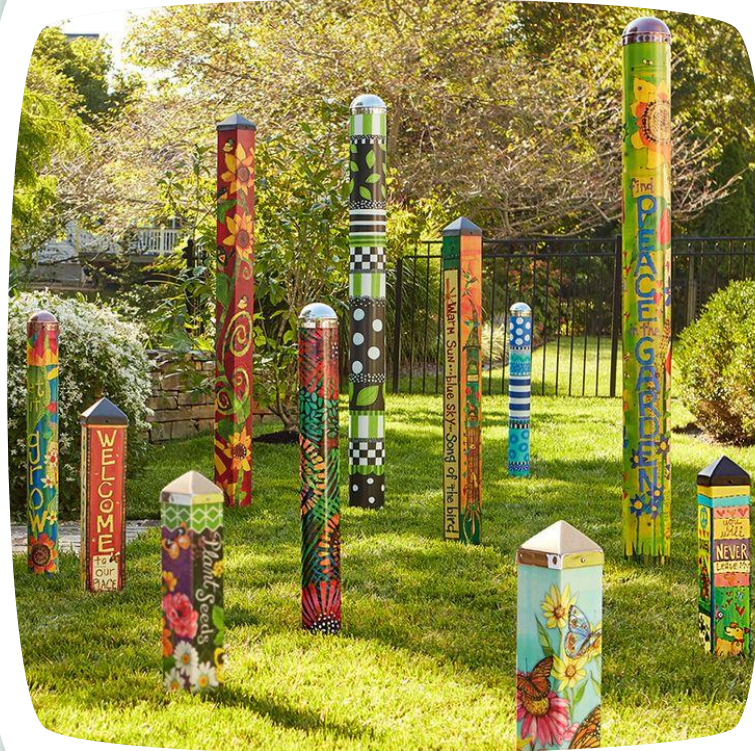
Partners in Character Education addresses the following objectives:
