Subject: **ROTARY D6910 - DISTRICT GOVERNOR NOMINEE DESIGNATE NOMINATIONS 2024-2025**

It is with great pleasure that I announce Rotary District 6910 is now accepting nominations to serve as Rotary District 6910 District Governor in the Rotary year 2024-2025.

Serving as Governor for an entire Rotary district is an incredible honor. Individuals that serve in this capacity are recognized leaders, nominated by their clubs to fill this important role.

The process of becoming a District Governor begins long before your year as Governor. Applicants for the position must fulfill certain requirements, including 1) having previously served as President of a Rotary club, and 2) being a member of Rotary for at least seven years by the time they become District Governor.

As per the District 6910 By-Laws Article IX Section 1 (link provided), the Governor Nominating Committee consists of the five (5) most recent past governors. They are as follows: Nominating Committee Chair, IPDG Tina Fischlin, PDG Don Martin, PDG Bruce Azevedo, PDG David Cooper and PDG Kim Waters.

What is the Nomination Process?

Nominations for District Governor are not made by individuals, but by Rotary clubs. The District exists for one purpose: to help support Rotary clubs. As such, the clubs submit members as candidates to be considered for the role of District Governor.

The nomination period will begin August 15 and end at midnight October 30.

The following documents must be submitted to be considered by the nominating committee.

Interview Process

Candidates for Governor whose paperwork is received by the deadline in good order will be invited to meet for an in-person interview. These interviews have been scheduled to begin at 10:00am, November 13, 2021 at the Rotary District 6910 office located at 958 McEver Road, Gainesville, Georgia. You will be notified of your time slot in advance of this date.

Interviews typically last 45-60 minutes and cover a wide range of topics. Once all the interviews are completed, the Nominating committee selects their proposed candidate for District Governor Nominee Designate. The “proposed” candidate will be notified within 24 hours by the Nominating Committee Chair.
