Program

Harry Lerch had the privilege of introducing world renowned wildlife sculptor Geoffrey Smith. Harry described Geoffrey's work as it "uplifts soul and spirit". Geoffrey grew up in Northern California and graduated from Montana State University. In 1996, after an interaction with John Payson of Hobe Sound and becoming tired of the cold weather, he moved to Stuart Florida where he now lives with his wife and five children. His best-known work is that of the Stuart Sailfish, an 18 foot monument situated in downtown Stuart that serves as the iconic symbol of the city. Smith began casting bronzes from the clay in 1984, after a successful career as a decoy carver. His upbringing on the northern California coast and later experiences in the wilds of Montana instilled a love of the natural world and a talent for patient observation of wildlife in its habitat. Nature and wildlife inspires much of his work.

Mr. Smith explained the casting process. All of his bronzes are yielded using the ancient lost-wax casting process, whereby a clay original of his creation is transformed at the foundry into an enduring bronze of limited issue. He invited the group to visit his studio in Port Salerno where the process is well described in an 8 minute video. The video features the beautiful Stuart Sailfish.
