JUPITER/ TEQUESTA ROTARY SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

There are two different types of scholarships being offered this year. To be considered for one of the Jupiter/Tequesta Rotary scholarships, it is mandatory to fully complete the application form. The application can be found on the JupiterRotary.com website under Documents.

The first type of scholarship offered by the Rotary Club is a traditional academic scholarship. All aspects of the scholarship application will be considered including the Essay 1.

The second type of scholarship will be open to high school seniors planning to attend a State College or other training facility to pursue a career in the trades.

Essay 1 for Regular Rotary Scholarships (\$1,500–\$2,500) — 1 Year Scholarships — Total Available \$20,000

On a separate sheet of paper, a one-page typed essay including the following:

- A brief summary of your volunteer efforts during your high school career.
- Describe your personal and professional goals.
- Describe any financial hardships that you face as you prepare for your post high school education.

Essay 2 for the Rotary-Boyhan Family American Heritage Scholarship — 1 Year \$5,000 Scholarship

This scholarship is limited to those students planning to pursue a career in the trades. All aspects of a student’s application will be considered, but the most important parts of this application will be the Essay 2 and financial need.

On a separate sheet of paper, a one-page Essay 2 include the following:

- The top 5 reasons the United States of America is a good and unique country.
- The top 5 ideas on how to make the United States an even better country.
- Please state which trade you wish to pursue and where you plan to learn this trade.

APPLICATION CHECKLIST

- Completed, signed scholarship application.
- Essay 1 or 2 as described in the guidelines.
- Letters of recommendation, i.e. teachers, guidance counselors, employers, ministers, etc.
- High School transcript, class rank, SAT/ACT scores, GPA weighted/unweighted.
