### The 2022 -2023 Citation Contest

This year's District Governor's Citation is a Self-Reported Contest. The hope is it will spur on a quest for gaining and sharing information regarding the vast resources Rotary offers to all members of Rotary – Earlyactors, Interactors, Rotaractors, and Rotarians.

#### **Get to know Rotary via the Monthly Themes – Allow them to Focus your Efforts**

How it will work –

The Clubs and by extension Areas will acquire points by completing opportunities on the provided list. There is no cap to how many times you can earn points using a specific option. For example, a Club can earn 2500 points by submitting 10 photos to the newsletter showing Rotarians in Action or for that matter 20,000 points for sponsoring 4 new Clubs.

Each Month on the last day of the month the Club Secretary will forward via email a completed spreadsheet to their Area Governor who will compile and provide the totals per Club in their Area to the District Executive Secretary (DES). The DES in turn will compile all the Area information and send it to the District Newsletter Chair and Public Image Chair no later than the 5<sup>th</sup> day of the month.

The totals will be published monthly in the District Newsletter and on the District Website. The list will present all the Clubs from highest to the lowest points balance to date. Because the different types of opportunities can vary greatly from one month to another no Club should think they have the completion all sewn up.

Each month the Area that scores the highest average (Score / # of Clubs) will be awarded 1000 points to distribute how they like. The top three Clubs monthly will also be awarded 500 points each.

All Clubs that generate at least 1000 points per month will be eligible for the citation.

Citation levels will be awarded as such:

01 – 10 Highest Points Per Capita – Citation with Platinum Distinction

11 – 20 Highest Points Per Capita – Citation with Gold Distinction

21 – 30 Highest Points Per Capita – Citation with Silver Distinction

31 – on Highest Points Per Capita – A Citation

At the end of the 22-23 Rotary Year:

- the top 3 highest giving Clubs per capita will be awarded 2000, 1000, 500 respectively.
- the top 5 Clubs will be placed in the running for the distinction of Top Club of the Year. There will be other Club distinctions as well.
- the top Area with the highest average (Score / # of Clubs) will be awarded the distinction of being the Area of the Year.

Of Note: This contest is open to ALL Clubs – Early Act, Interact, Rotaract, and Rotary (satellite Club points are reported in the sponsoring Club's total. If they form their own Club the points are deducted from main Club and will be added to their total from the date of creation). All points will be used to calculate the Area total.

1000	Combine with another Club to do a Service Event related to the Monthly Theme
1250	For each NEW Eligible PHS Member
1500	At Least 15% of Your Club Attends Your District Conference <small>(Increases by 100 points – each 5%+)</small>
