July

- \$6,600 donated to Mowat Middle School for Hurricane Michael relief projects not covered by the Bay County School District

#### August

- \$8,900 donated to Mosley High School for Hurricane Michael relief projects not covered by the Bay County School District
- \$2,600 donated to Bay Haven Middle School for Hurricane Michael relief projects not covered by the Bay County School District
- \$2,700 donated to North Bay Haven Middle School for Hurricane Michael relief projects not covered by the Bay County School District
- \$4,400 donated to North Bay Haven High School for Hurricane Michael relief projects not covered by the Bay County School District

### November

- \$5,000 (GRANT) donated to Dollywood Foundation Imagination Library Literacy Program providing monthly reading material to all first-grade students enrolled in Lynn Haven Elementary

## December

- \$6,300 donated to Simply Esteem of Bay County for Christmas gifts to local at-risk teenage girls

2020

February

- \$7,500 donated to City of Lynn Haven for rebuilding the Senior Center kitchen destroyed by Hurricane Michael
- \$325 provided in sponsorship of a local RYLA student; subsequently returned after course cancelled
- \$2,500 donated for Australian Wildfire Relief

#### March

- \$10,000 donated for Hurricane Dorian relief efforts in the Bahamas; donations collected from LH Rotary, GAC, Fyfe Family Foundation and LH Elementary School fundraising
- \$30,000 donated to the City of Lynn Haven to purchase trees through Arbor Day Foundation to replace trees lost from Hurricane Michael
- \$250 donated toward District Conference support; subsequently returned after Conference cancelled
- \$500 donated to Rotary Youth Camp of North Florida

### April

- \$500 donated to help Wild Root Café during COVID 19 forced business closures; a local business used as the club's meeting place after Hurricane Michael
- \$15,000 donated to ARC of the Bay, a local 501c3 supporting adults with disabilities; proceeds from annual club golf tournament

#### May

- \$100 donated to support Girls Inc Summer Camp operations

#### June

- \$600 donated toward materials in a restoration project at Rutherford High School; the grant and volunteer project is in partnership with the Lynn Haven garden club
- \$250 donated to the Community Breakfast at First United Methodist Church Panama City, Florida
