

The Rotary Club of Panama City Beach Arnold High School Interact Scholarship

MISSION

The Rotary Club of Panama City Beach is excited to announce scholarship for students who attend Arnold High School and who are members of the Interact club. The student who have a record of successful high school work and carry out the Rotary's mission of "Service Above Self" and who will be applying to any accredited two-year community/technical College or four-year University, are eligible to apply. The Rotary Club of Panama City Beach will give two (2), \$500 scholarship in May, based on academic success, community involvement, essay, and letters of recommendations.

The Rotary Club of Panama City Beach, Florida was chartered on January 1968. Club's membership focuses on service, fellowship, and education.

HERE'S HOW IT WORKS

The Rotary Club of Panama City Beach scholarship is open to any Arnold High School senior who is an active member of Interact Club. Only high school seniors who will enroll as undergraduates in the 2016-2017 academic year in a college, university, or technical school in the United States that holds accredited status with a regionally accrediting commission on higher education will be eligible.

The program consists of two (2) annual scholarship of \$500 each for use during the first year of undergraduate study. The award is a one-time award, which will be determined on a competitive basis using the following criteria:

- Academic record throughout high school = 25%
- Significant activities & contributions to the school and community = 50%
- Student essay = 25%

Deadline April 1, 2017. The winner will be notified by May 1, 2017, by certified mail.

The Rotary Club of Panama City Beach scholarship is open to any Arnold High School senior who is an active member of Interact Club. Only high school seniors who will enroll as undergraduates in the 2016-2017 academic year in a college, university, or technical school in the United States that holds accredited status with a regionally accrediting commission on higher education will be eligible. The application form, along with the high school transcript and letters of recommendation, must be completed and postmarked no later than April 1, 2017 to: Rotary Club of Panama City Beach Scholarship, Post Office Box 9279, Panama City Beach, Florida 32417.
