Program Chairman Jim Fikkert will introduce Lodewijk van den Berg, who is originally from The Netherlands. He holds a Masters and Ph.D. in Applied Science from the University of Delaware, and is currently employed as the Chief Scientist with Constellation Technology Corporation in Largo, Florida.



In 1985, he served as a Payload Specialist Astronaut, and also conducted crystal growth experiments in the reduced gravity environment of outer space while aboard the Shuttle and the Space Station. He specializes in the growth of single crystals of mercuric iodine from which nuclear detectors can be fabricated that can operate at ambient temperatures.

Last Week's Program;

Program Chairman Jerry Krauss, a "true giant among men," introduced George Linardos, CFA, CAIA, and Senior Vice President and East Regional Manager of Regions Bank. He leads a team of 10 portfolio managers and staff providing integrated investment advice and management for private bank, fiduciary and not-for-profit relationships.

Mr. Linardos has 30 years experience in the Investment management industry. He is a voting member of the firm's Asset Allocation Working Group.

Prior to joining Regions in 2001, he spent 16 years at INVEST Financial Corporation in Tampa, Florida managing the Research and Due Diligence Department.

George gave a very informative and interesting speech on the state of the economy in this country compared to the rest of the world. An interesting fact to all of us that the interest rate on 100 year bond in Switzerland is -2%. In Germany a 10 year bond is 0%.

The economy is presently in a 10 year growth period. The Federal Reserve is currently proposing to cut interest rates, which is highly unusual, considering a low unemployment rate of 3.7% and a healthy stock market growth. He indicates that there are signs that the manufacturing sector is slowing down or weakening.

The expected growth rates for 2019 (2.1%) and 2020 (1.8%) are steady.
