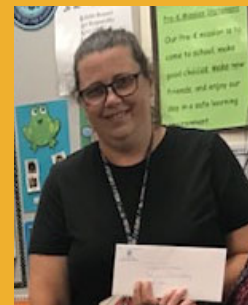
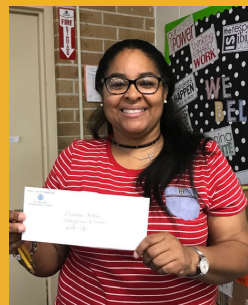
Teacher/Speaker Awards (\$25) presented by Rotarians Harry Alchin & Janet Waddell to teachers at Pinellas Central Elementary School:
