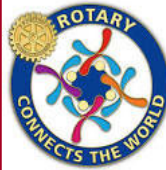

Last Week's Program:

Program Chairman Jeff MacKellar introduced **Antony Cooke**, certainly one of the best known speakers in the history of our club. He is an American Cellist, Recording Artist, author of several books, Astronomer, and Musicologist. His Father was internationally renowned cellist **Nelson R. Cooke**. Tony was born in Sydney, Australia, and studied at the Royal College of Music. He started playing at age 6. He has produced record albums (*Beethoven: The Complete Works for Cello and Piano* and many others); and written books on Astronomy (*Visual Astronomy, Dark Nebulae, Astronomy and Climate, Make Time for the Stars*). He was awarded the prestigious Order of Australia AM, one of the highest awards an Australian citizen can receive. He later became a University Professor at USF. He was the youngest principal cellist in England. He moved to Hollywood in 1984, and has participated in approximately 1,500 movie soundtracks, including *The Amazing Spider Man, Avatar, Back to the Future, Mrs. Doubtfire, ET, Pirates of the Caribbean, Star Trek, Superman Returns, Titanic, Sleepless in Seattle* and many more. His cello is over 300 years old and insured for six figures.
