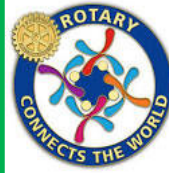

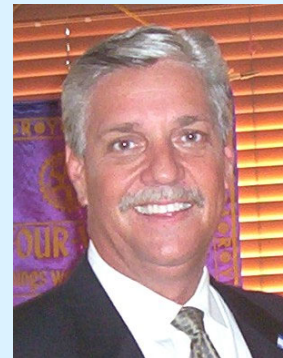

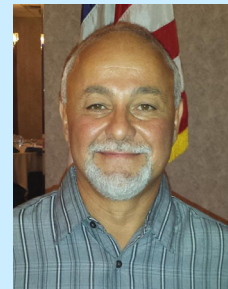

This Week's Program:

Program Chairman David Sideri will provide a discussion about the process of electroplating and how the very important work that he does at his company, AdTec II, affects our lives.

Electroplating is a process of depositing a layer of any desired metal or another material by means of electricity.

Electroplating is primarily used to change the surface properties of an object, but may also be used to build up thickness on undersized parts or to form objects by electroforming. The process used in electroplating is called electrodeposition. The most common form of electroplating is used for creating coins, such as U.S. pennies, which are made of zinc covered in a layer of copper.

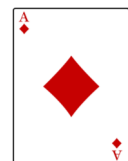
