Last Week's Program:

Program Chairman Jim Fikkert introduced **James Barr**, who is the *Director of Clinical Outreach and Emergency Management* at **Bayfront Medical Center**. James, who is a retired Paramedic and Firefighter, after 25 years, is a St. Petersburg native.

Mr. Barr gave us an update on the protocols that Bayfront Medical Center has undertaken for the "new normal" Covid-19.

Bayfront was built on a burial ground site, and started out in 1908 as a Sanitorium. The center currently has a capacity for 485 patients, with the emergency care center having 43 private rooms. It is the third busiest hospital in Pinellas County, averaging about 50 new emergency room patients per day.

Bayfront was the first area hospital to have a helicopter pad, and began life saving helicopter service in 1986. It is the only Level II Trauma Center in Pinellas County and a Level IV Epilepsy Center.

The hospital also acts as a training center for Special Forces Paramedics. A Special Forces Paramedic must act in the field as both a paramedic and a dentist, and also sometimes performs veterinary medicine in small villages.

Bayfront spent \$26 million to renovate the emergency center last year.

James urges everyone to develop an emergency preparedness plan for disasters such as hurricanes, and recommends having a 10 day supply of fresh water.
