Last Week's Program: **Program Chairperson** Chantel Wonder introduced Tony Cornicello, Manager for the Tampa Bay Rise Against Hunger location. Tony was in a very good mood that day since he had just returned from







Virginia, where he had proposed to his Fiancée. She said "yes"!

Rotary has a longstanding relationship with *Rise Against Hunger*, which has 20 offices in the United States, and 6 international offices. The organization was founded in 1998 by Ray Buchanan, a Methodist Minister and a Rotarian. The goal of the organization is to "seek to create immediate nourishment while implementing sustainable solutions." The four focus areas are *Nourishing Lives*; Empowering Communities; Providing Emergency Relief; and Growing the **Movement.** The organization provides meals and nutrition through schools and



orphanages. The meal packs consist of rice, dehydrated vegetables, soy, and vitamins. In 2019 alone, they packaged 77.4 million meals for 36 countries. The organization was featured in the March 2017 issue of *Rotarian* Magazine, and 30 million meals were packaged by Rotarians in 2017. The need is growing exponentially due to the current pandemic.

Next Week's Program:

Program Chairperson Kenny Krauss will introduce Mike Piacenza, who is a Detective with the Criminal Investigations Section of the City of Pinellas Park Police Department. His presentation will be about preventing scams and fraud through on-line technology, as well as preventing internet crimes against children. Mike investigates many different types of technology



crimes, and has been involved with several interesting cases involving businesses.



This Week's Program:

Program Chairman Jeff MacKellar will introduce Sean Sullivan, who has served as the Executive Director of the *Tampa* Bay Regional Council for the last five vears. The Council serves six counties and twenty-one cities throughout the Tampa Bay Region. Mr. Sullivan spent over thirty



years working in the Planning, land use, environmental, zoning and public transportation fields. Prior to joining the Council, Sean worked at the Federal Transit Administration in Cambridge Massachusetts where he managed capital projects, environmental compliance and operational finances for transit agencies throughout New England. Mr. Sullivan earned a Bachelor's Degree in Political Science from the University of Massachusetts, Lowell and a Master in Public Administration from Suffolk University in Boston.
