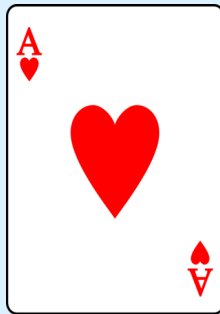
**In Person:**

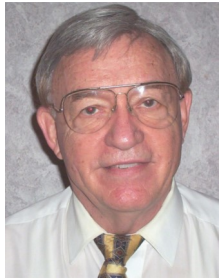
