Outgoing Club President Tom Stewart, who did a remarkable job over the past year, held his final Club Assembly meeting. Our club contributed over \$52,435 in community donations, plus an additional \$5,200 from our Pinellas Park Foundation. This included One Hundred \$50 checks to school teachers in Pinellas Park. Tom increased the amount of the checks from \$25 to \$50 this year. Despite the death of two prominent members, we actually increased our membership, by adding four new members: Tim Hammond, Debra Ellis-Abney, Bob Kelzer and Tampa Bay Regional Planning Council. During the past year our club impacted many lives. Eight students were helped by *Confident Smiles Dentistry*, headed up by Rotarians Nhi Nguyen & Alex Cruz. Despite the pandemic, we were able to provide Christmas Baskets to 40 Families, and Easter Baskets to 20 *Ronald McDonald House families*, which were greatly appreciated. Other highlights - the *First Annual Heroes Awards*, the Bowl-A-Thon, providing 4 Clothing Racks & Reusable Rotary Logo Bags to the *Hollins High School Food and Clothing Pantry* and supplying 4 misting fans for *Rawlings Elementary School PE Dept.* Great Leadership, Tom!


