



Last Week's Program:

Program Chairperson Don Higgins introduced **Charlie Rogers**, a Rotarian of 42 years with 42 years of perfect attendance. Charlie served as a President's Representative for 8 years; on the Council of Legislation Representative



for 3 years; Rotary International Training Leader for 2 years; and District 6980 (Central Florida) Governor in 2000-01. He and his wife are both Major Donors, Bequest Society Members and *Paul Harris Society* members of the **Rotary Foundation**. He thanked our club for being a 100% Paul Harris Club.

Charlie retired from a 34-year career in banking. He and his wife, who is also a Rotarian, reside in Port Richey, Florida.

Charlie talked to us about **The Rotary Foundation**, and provided an update on the Rotary effort to eradicate polio. In 1985, there were 350,000 cases of Polio worldwide, spanning 125 countries. In 2019, we were down to 176 cases, and the number dropped to 140 in 2020. In 2021, there have been only two new cases reported, one in Afghanistan and the other in Pakistan. In order to declare that a disease has been eradicated, we need to have 3 years with no cases. There has been only one disease (Smallpox) eradicated. Hopefully, Polio will be the second. Rotary is working in conjunction with **The Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation**. **The Rotary Foundation** funds International and District projects and grants. To date, over 2.1 Billion dollars have been spent on eradicating Polio around the world.

Homes are sold at no profit and no interest to households who do not qualify for a traditional mortgage. The program also prepares homeowner partners to be successful through an education curriculum of 20 classes from budgeting to home maintenance.
