Last Week's Program:

Program Chairperson Wren Krahl introduced Ms. Alana Todd. who serves as the Environmental Planner for the *Tampa Bay* Regional Planning Council. Alana supports the work being done on regional environmental management and resilience-related activities, including the Agency on Bay Management. She holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Environmental Science and Policy and a Bachelor of Arts degree in Anthropology from the *University*



of South Florida, as well as a Master of Science in Marine-Estuarine and Environmental Science from the *University of Maryland*. She also serves as a staff member for the Courtney Campbell Causeway Scenic Highway and Florida Department of Emergency Management Stormwater Grant Program. Alana is the beloved Granddaughter of Pinellas Park Rotarian Barbara Todd MacKellar.

Alana presented a talk on current environmental topics, such as Red Tide, as well as the environmental journal, Bay Soundings, which is now in its 19th year. Red Tide is caused by the growth of microscopic algae called Karenia brevis, that produces toxins that kill fish and make shellfish dangerous to eat. Alana provided us with an informative presentation on the importance of sea grass to the health of the bay. The Bay was considered dead 50 years ago and concerted effort by local governments and environmental groups had brought the bay back to a healthy state. The Piney Point spill is exacerbating the red tide and has set the health of the bay back decades.

Wheels St. Petersburg, and Meals on Wheels for Kids. Caitlyn also administers the Emergency Food and Shelter Program (EFSP) for Hillsborough and Pinellas County and oversees the Hunger Gap Map, a

premier interactive meal gap map tracker. Caitlyn has developed and helped launch Programs to End Hunger all over the State of Florida and most recently has created and expanded the Meals on Wheels for Kids program, both locally and nationally.

Before devoting her full time to **TBNEH**, Caitlyn owned her own company, Next Stop Produce, one of the first mobile produce trucks in Tampa Bay to serve low-income individuals and neighborhoods. Caitlyn grew up in Punta Gorda and graduated from University of South Florida in 2011. She lived in St. Pete Beach for almost 9 years, but recently moved to New Tampa with her husband and son. She enjoys traveling to the mountains in Georgia, gardening, and cooking with her family.
