Last Week's Program: Program Chairperson Richard Breske presented a celebration of the life and accomplishments of long time Rotarian Joe Kolodziej. Joe's family and friends in attendance included wife Priscilla, son Joe Kolodziej, Jr.; and daughter, Jackie. Richard told Priscilla that with the money that Joe & she donated, trees would be planted, but she will never sit under them; food would be sent to starving children in Africa but she will never be invited to



the dinner; books will be provided to children in India, but she will never be there to see them graduate; and micro banks will be financed so that men and women can start new businesses in developing countries and stand on their own two feet, but she will not meet them. Rotarians around the world will do good with the money that Joe and Priscilla donated to the Rotary Foundation. They are the face of Rotary! Joe was a former member of the *Seabees*, and a huge *Miami Dolphin* fan. We believe it's fairly safe to say that he was the only Rotarian who owned a pet Tiger! Joe was born in Long Branch, New Jersey in 1939, and moved to our area in the 1960s. Joe Kolodziej was a Paul Harris' Major Donor, giving more than \$10,000. He was brought into Rotary in June, 2008 by Rotarian Phil England. Joe was widely known as the luckiest man in Rotary. Joe entered the *Paul Harris' Lottery* 44 times and won 8 times, almost 20%, which is almost double the expected 10% win rate. Representative Rotarians, Jerry Krauss, Kevin

Krauss, Kenny Krauss, Phil England, Don Higgins and Theresa Pinnix, came forward to give their fond memories of Joe through his Rotary years. Joe Minarik talked about meeting Joe many years ago when their sons were small and played together and hearing all of Joe's Seabee stories. He also related Joe's winning ways in the Rotary Lottery as he held our current quarter's Lottery.
