Krauss introduced **Karen Vlahos**, the Pinellas Co. Business Development Representative for **Baycare Home Care**. She has been with **Baycare** for ten years. She previously lived in Los Angeles, CA for 16 years, where she worked as a Recreation Therapist in hospital and rehab centers until she decided to go into pharmaceutical sales. She moved to Florida in 2006 to be near her family. She started her career in Home Health Services with **Baycare** after she moved to FL in 2006. Baycare Home Health care provides a variety of in-home services. A patient must be homebound in order to receive assistance from **Baycare**. They accept Medicaid and all other insurance providers, but not Humana options. Some of the services **Baycare** provides include physical therapy, occupational therapy and social work assistance. **Baycare** also provides medical equipment which is either dropped off at the patients home or given to them when leaving the hospital. **Carelink** is a emergency response system for seniors who live alone and are at risk for falling. **Baycare** services thirteen counties in the state of Florida!
