Program Chairperson Caitlin Peacock introduced **Jason Bent**, an **Associate Dean for Academic Affairs and Professor of Law** with the **Stetson University College of Law**. He graduated *Magna Cum Laude from the University of Michigan Law School*.



Jason became a Professor at the Stetson University College of Law in

2011. He previously practiced Law for 9 years. Dr. Bent focuses on employment law, employment discrimination law, and civil procedure. He co-authored a legal treatise entitled, *The Statistics of Discrimination: Using Statistical Evidence In Discrimination Cases.* He also co-authored *An Illustrated Guide to Civil Procedure*.

Stetson Law School was founded in 1900, and is the oldest Law School in Florida. The main campus is located in Gulfport, however, Stetson also has a Tampa campus, which features a part-time program. The college is currently leasing space to the District Court of Appeals on the Tampa Campus.

Stetson is currently ranked #2 in Advocacy and #5 in Legal Writing by *US News*. Stetson's winning record in dispute resolution, trial team, and moot court competitions over the past 36 years is unmatched by any other Law School, with five (5) World (International) Championships and 81 National Championships. Dr Bent is very proud of their work in cold case resolutions, proving the innocence of wrongly convicted persons.
