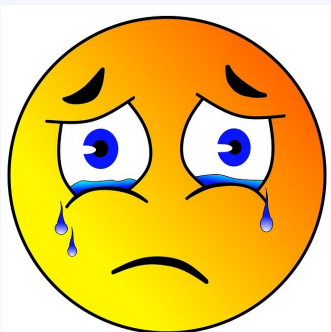


Happy Events Janet

Last Week's Program:

Program Chairperson David Allen presented a program entitled, "*Recreational Vehicles Fellowship of Rotarians.*" (RVF)

The RVF is one of many fellowships of Rotary in which members have a common bond. In RVF's case, that bond is a love for camping and rallies in various scenic locations in North America. Members include Rotarians from the US, Canada, Europe and Australia. Gatherings are called "Rallies" in North America and "Musters" in Australia. There are 370 groups in the US and Canada, 677+ in Europe, and 450+ in Australia. David provided photos from the last Rally in upstate New York, which is near the beautiful Finger Lakes and Niagara Falls. There are also scenic waterfalls near Watkins Glen and Letchworth State Park, which is also considered as New York Wine Country. The Rallies usually consist of social gatherings, dinners, and tours of nearby attractions. Their next Rally will be in Houston, near the NASA Space Center. There is also a Muster scheduled for May 27, 2023 in Melbourne, Australia. David is a member of RVF, and encourages all Rotarians who have a love for camping, be it in a popup tent trailer or a Class A motorhome, to consider joining the group.
