Program Chairperson Ken Bray scheduled Devon Francke, the Education Program Coordinator for Keep Pinellas Beautiful, Inc. (KPB), however Ken was not able to attend the meeting and introduce Devon due to Ken's onset of Covid that day. We hope Ken is feeling better this week.



KPB is the local Keep America Beautiful affiliate,

and focuses on the education of national and global environmental issues that impact the Tampa Bay area. Devon started working at KPB in May of 2018. He focuses on engaging the community in both virtual and educational experiences and leading beach cleanups focused on the removal of plastics from our waterways. Devon became interested in marine biology after scuba diving the Great Barrier Reef of Australia. He earned his Master's Degree in Marine Science at Hawaii Pacific University.

Among the greatest concerns to the Scientific community is the presence of plastics and microplastics in our waterways. KPB has created a Microplastics Program to educate Pinellas County citizens about the harm that plastic litter causes and what we can do to limit plastic pollution. Among the most common sources of plastics are Styrofoam, plastic lids, straws, plastic water and drink bottles, plastic grocery bags, and plastic bottle caps. His PowerPoint presentation was not only informative, but also attention grabbing with his animations!


Next Week's Program:
