Lindsay has profit and loss responsibility and is accountable for the site's operational and financial performance. She is recognized for building and leading high-performing teams through effective communication, strategic thinking, and a focus on operational excellence. Over her 14-year career, Lindsay has held roles of increasing responsibilities both at Lockheed Martin and McMaster-Carr. She has supported multiple programs across Rotary Mission Systems (RMS), Information Systems & Global Solutions (IS&GS), Space, and Aeronautics at seven different Lockheed Martin facilities. Her team's motto is **"One team, no seam"**.

Lindsay holds a Bachelors of Science in Engineering from Harvey Mudd College and a Masters of Business Administration from Villanova University. She is part of the Production Operations Leadership Institute (POLI), and Lead & Innovate for Tomorrow (LIFT) program. Lindsay is a Certified Lean Six Sigma Black Belt, Certified Cost Account Manager (CAM) and **Prosci** Change Practitioner. Lindsay serves as a Board Member and Trustee of the **Gateway Chamber of Commerce** in Pinellas Park and on the Board of **Girls, Inc.**

Lockheed-Martin operates in 44 states and has 114,000 employees. The Pinellas facility's primary function is to build and assemble airplane canopies. Canopies need to be changed about every 500 flight hours.
