This Week's Program: Program Chairman Don

Higgins introduced Karen Mathews who has served as the East House Manager at Ronald McDonald House Charities Tampa Bay for seven years. Karen presented a slide program via Zoom. The mission of RHMC, to help families with sick, pediatric children, is unchanged. Ronald McDonald House Charities is part of an international organization with 375 locations in 46 countries. There are four houses in the Tampa Bay area, with the first opening in 1980. Life is different at the Ronald McDonald Houses right now, but the East House has remained open



throughout the pandemic and everyone continues to do well. The Ronald McDonald East House provides premade delivered dinners from local restaurants every night for their families. The Central & West St Pete and the Tampa House have recently re-opened to new families. No volunteers are currently

allowed at any of the houses. There are also no family style meals provided. The community dining room is closed. All residents have two rooms, one for sleeping and one for eating with a table and refrigerator in the second room. Covid-19 testing for all families and masks are mandatory, and extensive cleaning procedures have been put in place. They planned a scavenger hunt and movie for the families at Halloween. There is a reduced occupancy at all of the houses. RHMC has partnered with Marriott hotels to house some families. There have been no staff furloughs during the pandemic.
