

Last Week's Program:

Program Chairman Brian Ellis introduced **Andrew Warren**, *Hillsborough County State Attorney*, 13th Judicial Circuit of Florida. He engaged our membership through a Zoom presentation with a discussion on criminal justice reform. His mission is to make Hillsborough County safer while promoting justice and fairness to everyone and by finding smart alternatives to prison for first time, non-violent and juvenile offenders in N CONSTRUCTION OF CONSTRUCTUON OF CONSTRUCTUON

order to efficiently use tax dollars and reduce recidivism. He explained that the prison system is badly underfunded and understaffed. The four goals of criminal justice are (1) Retribution; (2) Rehabilitation; (3) Restitution and (4) Recidivism. Unfortunately, in this country the focus has always been on Retribution. Andrew previously served as a federal prosecutor, and spent the majority of his career with the Justice Department prosecuting complex financial fraud cases all across the country. He studied political science and economics at Brandeis University before receiving his law degree from Columbia University. He was born and raised in Gainesville, Florida. Andrew is striving to make his Tampa office a model of what a prosecutor's office should be across the entire country. He has 130 Assistant State Attorneys working alongside him, as well as a talented group of investigators, victim advocates and support staff. His vision is to look at the long term consequences of prosecution and to engage in partnership with the community in order to reduce recidivism through what he calls "Smart Justice."

Next Week's Program:

Program Chairman Ken Bray will introduce **Laura Hine**, a member of the **Pinellas County School Board**, **District One**. Laura holds a degree in **Aerospace Engineering** from the U. S. Naval Academy.



Laura was an Officer in the U.S. navy and has a passion for strong public education. Pinellas County Schools is a 1.5 billion dollar operation, and is the largest landowner and the largest employer in Pinellas County, and has over

100,000 students in their schools. She states **"We must respect each other, hear each other, dream together and sharpen our pencils together to achieve the very best we can for every student."** We look forward to hearing from her next week.
