Last Week's Program:

Club President Tom Stewart, subbing for Program Chairman Jim Andrew introduced **William Dailey**, the *College and Career Center Manager* from **Pinellas Park High School**. He spoke to us about the school's College and Career Center, whose slogan is *Elevating Excellence*. The College and Career Centers support students and families, helping to access resources, explore college opportunities and work collaboratively on:



- Career pathway and college major exploration
- College exploration and match
- Application development and submission
- SAT/ACT preparation resources
- College Fair and admission events
- Financial and scholarship planning
- Essay preparation and review

The program was started at Robinson High School in Tampa, and was expanded to Pinellas County in 2019. William started the programs at Pinellas Park and Seminole High Schools. In addition to Pinellas Park & Seminole High Schools, the program has now been expanded to Gibbs HS, Boca Ciega HS, Clearwater HS, Lakewood HS, Hollins HS, and Dunedin HS. There has been some regression in scholarship and FAFSA applications this year among students due to the Pandemic, so volunteers are needed to work with the students. Training is provided. Volunteers can serve as industry / career ambassadors, or contribute to the counseling of students as they make decisions about their college plans or career options. They also work with the students who will continue their education at Pinellas Technical Center to train for technical professions.
