**Rotary Opens Opportunities!** 

Last Week's Program: **Program Chairman Alex** Cruz introduced Becky **Dineen**, a State of Florida Apiary (Bee) Inspector. Apiary Inspectors advise Florida Beekeepers on honeybee health, certify bees for shipment and monitor ports, highways, and other high-risk areas for honeybee pests and diseases. Honeybees account for 30% of our food. A honeybee needs pollen, nectar, tree resin and water. The tree resin is used like glue to seal up areas of the hive. The hive is made up of three



castes, the (female) worker bees (90-95%), the (male) drones (5-10%), and the queens. The queens are fed only royal jelly, whereas the others are fed primarily "bee bread." There is generally only one queen per colony. A queen lays 1,000-2,000 eggs per day. The hive can produce a new queen within 16 days by feeding an egg only royal jelly. It takes 21 days for workers to hatch and 24 days for drones. A queen can fly up to 100 yards to mate with drones from another hive. Drones and workers can only fly about 50 yards.

Alex is also an amateur beekeeper. His Grandfather had 5-6 hives and sparked



Alex's interest as a child. Becky brought her husband, Art, to the meeting. She and her husband have spent 7 years as Beekeepers. There are over 5,000 Beekeepers residing in Florida. Becky brought delicious samples of honey for everyone to taste and purchase.
