Rick opened Butler Realty in 1981, and is a past President of the *Pinellas Park Kiwanis Club*, a member of the *Gateway Chamber of Commerce*, as well as the *Pinellas Park Boys and Girls Club*. He has been recognized as a past *Citizen of the Year* in Pinellas Park. He is also a Past President of the *Suncoast League of Cities*.

Rick was first elected to the Pinellas Park City Council in 1998 and has also served on the *Florida State Homeless Leadership Board* for 14 years.

He is a current Governor-appointed member of the *Juvenile Welfare Board*.
