# Last Week's Program:

Program Chairperson Janet Waddell introduced **Shana August** from *Hollins High School*. Shana chairs the *Hollins High School Food and Clothing Pantry*. Shana
reached out to us a few months ago with a need for new
clothing racks, reusable bags and hangers. **President Tom Stewart** found a way to provide these items. We purchased
500 reusable bags with our Pinellas Park Rotary Club logo
for the food pantry, two each of the clothing racks shown
below and many Rotarians donated extra plastic hangers from
their closets for the clothing pantry.



Shana was approached by the Hollins HS administration 7 years ago and asked to "teach" a "Community" class. The class was formed as a Truancy avoidance class for students who were in drop-out prevention. Since the school is a Title I school, she was asked to start a food pantry to help students who are in need of food assistance. The school has partnered with *John Hopkins Hospital* and *Feeding Tampa Bay* to provide food for the students. Last year with the Pandemic the need increased, becoming a need to feed the student, their family AND the community. Students have stepped forward to help organize food for 60-80 families this past year. *Publix* bakeries have joined the partnership to provide day old bread and pastries for the food baskets. *Feeding Tampa Bay* provides Meat, Produce and Dry Goods for the baskets. The students are in charge of keeping inventory records and preparing the clothes



pantry after they are donated. Shana's students are learning compassion, finding out that many have more pressing needs than they do. They are learning to give back to their community by partnering with Elementary Schools, pumpkin patches and other community programs. This class has satisfied her passion to teach, to get the students involved in their community and reminds her each day that the youth of today are good kids, interested in helping their community.
