We are sure you are wondering what you should bring with you to S4TL. Here is a list of items provided by S4TL and a list of items that you may wish to include in your baggage.

**WHAT TO BRING:**

- Jeans/Shorts (Not Short Shorts or Short Skirts), comfortable shoes, swimsuit, extra towels. **Please do not bring bib overalls** as they are not allowed during the seminar sessions. You may wish to bring your own pillow, soap (personal and if you wish, laundry soap)
- **Your own pillow(s) and blanket(s) for sleeping.** Sheets and towels will be provided as noted below.
- Personal toiletries, a heavier blanket as dorms tend to run chilly.
- Sports equipment (tennis and/or racquetball racquet & balls)
- **Talent Show props - such as musical instruments, costumes, etc.**

**PROVIDED BY S4TL:**

- HOUSING - Dormitory room is shared with at least one other delegate.
- LINENS - 2 sheets, 2 towels & 1 washcloth. (You may wish to bring extras)
- SHIRTS -Three (3) short sleeved shirts for wear during the Seminar (yellow) which will be laundered twice during the seminar for you.
- MEALS -Three meals daily at the student cafeteria, plus evening snacks.

- 5) DELEGATES WILL NOT LEAVE THE CAMPUS UNLESS ACCOMPANIED BY A ROTARIAN STAFF MEMBER.
- 6) DELEGATES MAY NOT BRING BEEPERS AND/OR CELL PHONES TO SEMINAR SESSIONS.
- 7) DELEGATES WILL ABIDE BY ALL REASONABLE STANDARDS OF CONDUCT.
- 8) DELEGATES WILL CONFORM WITH STANDARD HIGH SCHOOL DRESS CODE.
