Dear Rotary Club President and S4TL Representative:

After the last couple years of Covid, we are happy to be back at Florida Southern College for the 2022 Seminar For Tomorrow's Leaders. We are resuming the annual timing of delegates arriving on Father's Day Sunday and graduation on Saturday at the end of the week. RAP sessions will be held on campus for Rotarians to participate directly with program & delegates.

Important dates to remember are outlined below and a description of the Seminar for Tomorrow's Leaders project, also known as S4TL, is included. This youth leadership seminar is a joint project of Rotary Districts 6890, 6950 and 6960, and has gained popularity each year, so we encourage you to get started planning for your club's participation early. The Rotary Clubs in all three districts have the opportunity to sponsor at least one high school student of exceptional potential to attend the weeklong S4TL program in June. We only have room for a maximum of 165 delegates so please adhere strictly to the deadline dates indicated below.

SEMINAR DATES: Sunday, June 19, 2022 - Saturday, June 25, 2022 Florida Southern College, Lakeland, Florida

DUE DATES: *February 28, 2022 - CLUB RESERVATIONS DUE*
April 30, 2022 - DELEGATE APPLICATION FORMS DUE

The student you select must have **just COMPLETED his/her Junior year** at the time of the Seminar. **No one other than incoming seniors will be accepted as delegates.** Other specific guidelines for selecting an appropriate delegate will be forwarded upon receipt of your delegate reservation. Due to the limited space available, each club will be guaranteed only one delegate. If there is space available after the February 28th deadline, additional delegates will be given to those clubs sponsoring students from more than one high school first, then to all other clubs who request more than one delegate. I have not yet had to deny a club from sending multiple delegates. If you are interested in increasing your delegate count from previous years, please give me a call to discuss.

One of our goals each year is to provide training to students from as many different high schools as possible. Therefore, we are asking clubs from the same city or locality to coordinate their selections if at all possible. Please try to send us representation from as many different high schools as possible. If you need help finding a high school from which to select a delegate, please give me a call and I may be able to help you.

Enclosed is a delegate reservation form. Be advised that **you do not need to know the name of your delegate at this time.**

This reservation form only insures your club a space for your delegate when chosen. We must have your reservation form with a reservation fee of **\$700.00, postmarked NO LATER THAN February 28, 2022.** If your club's form is postmarked later than that date, all spaces may have been already allocated to other Rotary clubs. We know you will want to give S4TL priority status. If you need assistance, please call me.
