Dear Rotary Club President and S4TL Representative:

The 2024 Seminar for Tomorrow's Leaders (S4TL) will be held at Florida Southern College again this year. Delegates arrive on Father's Day, Sunday June 16th and graduation will be on Saturday June 22nd. RAP sessions will be held on campus for Rotarians to participate directly with program & delegates on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday of the seminar week. More information on RAP sessions will be sent to clubs as we get closer to the seminar.

This youth leadership seminar is a joint project of Rotary Districts 6890, 6950 and 6960, and has gained popularity each year, so we encourage you to get started planning for your club's participation early. Rotary Clubs in all three districts are given the opportunity to sponsor at least one high school student of exceptional potential to attend the weeklong seminar in June. We only have room for a maximum of 165 delegates so please adhere strictly to the deadline dates indicated below.

The student you select must have **just COMPLETED his/her junior year** at the time of the Seminar. **No one other than incoming seniors will be accepted as delegates.** Other specific guidelines for selecting an appropriate delegate will be forwarded upon receipt of your delegate reservation. Due to the limited space available, each club will be guaranteed only one delegate. If there is space available after the February 28th deadline, additional delegates will be given to those clubs sponsoring students from more than one high school first, then to all other clubs who request more than one delegate. We have not yet had to deny a club from sending multiple delegates. If you are interested in increasing your delegate count from previous years, please call your District's S4TL Chair, Tom Norton, to discuss.

One of our goals each year is to provide training to students from as many different high schools as possible. Therefore, we are asking clubs from the same city or locality to coordinate their selections, if possible. Please try to send us representatives from as many different high schools as possible. If you need help finding a high school from which to select a delegate, please call your district's S4TL chairperson for assistance.

Enclosed is a delegate reservation form. Be advised that **you do not need to know the name of your delegate at this time.**

This reservation form ensures your club a space for your delegate(s) when chosen. We must have your reservation form with a reservation fee of **\$800.00 per delegate, postmarked NO LATER THAN February 28, 2024.** If your club's form is postmarked later than that date, all spaces may have already been allocated to other Rotary clubs. We know you will want to give S4TL priority status. If you need assistance, please don't hesitate to give me a call or reach out to me via email.
