Jon volunteered his expertise in doing barbeque.

He also talked about Area 4 Governor Erika raising \$64,000 last year for Shelter Box (also an affiliated program.) He asked how our club collaborated with other clubs. Gary talked about the Food Truck, Gift of Life, Wheelchair Foundation, Smile Train for cleft palate, etc.

Joe and others talked about the survey and how the members expressed their choices of projects. Then Betty Jean asked Jon about his experiences and he talked about his life changing experience when he went to Belize delivering wheelchairs and how the 5 recipients of Gift of Life came there to thank the Rotarians for what they had done to help them. (I wish every Rotarian will have that kind of experience at least once in their life). Years later Jon was encouraged by Rob from Long Island, NY to raise money for Gift of Life and they raised \$250,000 for a hospital.

Jon talked about commitment and said there should be no Plan B. This means you are totally committed to the project.

His club is going to Bahamas to deliver wheelchairs (any of our members interested in going?). He touched on polio eradication, the recent setbacks and the recommitment to eradication. Then he went on to: Clean Water Projects, Books for Children, Dictionary Day, Youth Exchange, Josh The Otter (not an approved program yet), Rota Kids (which Joanne including the plans for this school year) and Interact. He also put a plug in for DG Rich so visit, as well as our next District Conference in Naples on May 7-9th, 2020.
