• Art's birthday is February 1. We will celebrate it next week.

The Sergeant-at-Arms and Happy/Sad dollars were postponed until next week. Treasurer Dixon Blevins was sad no \$\$\$\$.

A check presentation to the Gift of Life from our club in the amount of \$2,900 was made to our guest speaker, Alfred C. Current III. This money went towards a grant (**Rick Perry** started the grant and ask up to assist in part of the initial funding) that totaled \$90,000. Wayne Hemstead, Steve, and Gary made the presentation. This grant will go towards creating sustainability of the Gift of Life program by training medical personnel in Mexico and San Salvador.

Our guest speaker, **Alfred C. Current III, Chair of The Rotary Foundation,** educated us on the purpose and power of The Rotary Foundation. Highlights of his informative and motivating talk included:

- A polio historical perspective from a young boy in North Carolina
- A current update of the End Polio Now initiative
- The eradication of polio remains the #1 priority of Rotary International
- Why? It is still an issue in Pakistan and Afghanistan
- We will not stop until polio is eradicated.
- What can our club do?
 - Create an event for the October 24 World Polio Day to raise awareness
 - Know that for every dollar we (as a club or personally as a club member) designate for the End Polio Now initiative, the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation matches it 2-1. If you have \$100 and designate it to The Rotary Foundation for End Polio Now, it becomes \$300; \$1000 becomes \$3000; \$3000 becomes \$9000 ...
- Alfred reminded us of the Rotary 6 areas of focus and what we do. He also shared that all 6 areas now have an ecological impact part integrated into it. This is in response to the ever increasing urgency of the climate change issues impacting our world at an alarming rate.

Alfred then shared how the District Designated Fund magically (ok, so it isn't magic!) makes our money multiply. And, as a reminder, the Charity Navigator watchdog group who evaluates charitable organizations, has given Rotary International and The Rotary Fund the highest possible rating year after year. We received "A #1 Among Best Charities Everyone Has Heard Of" rating. While there are many metrics for receiving this high rating; it boils down to the fact that we are careful and thoughtful stewards of the money we receive.

Learning how to leverage the Rotary Foundations takes time ...
