

New Member (Red Ribbon) Checklist

New Rotarians in the St. Augustine Sunrise Club are obligated to display their status as new members by wearing a red ribbon affixed to their Rotary badge. The new member must retain this ribbon until the following conditions are met and signed off by a club officer:

- 1. Attendance at 10 sanctioned Rotary events (weekly meetings, monthly socials, service projects, Rotary District events). Please notify the club secretary if you attend any of the following, so that you may receive credit:
 - a. Another Rotary club's meeting
 - b. Rotary Social Event
 - c. Rhythm & Ribs Planning Meeting
 - d. Rotary District Event
 - e. Participation in a Rotary Service Project
- 2. Lead our club in an Invocation at the beginning of a weekly meeting. See your club President to schedule your Invocation.
- 3. Spend a morning acting as a Greeter before the meeting. This involves:
 - a. Arriving no later than 7:15 AM
 - b. Greeting arriving Rotarians at the Badge table and assisting with locating their badges.
 - c. Introducing yourself and remembering others' names and vocations.
- 4. Lead the club in the recitation of the Four Way Test at the conclusion of a Weekly Meeting. See your club President to schedule your time.
- 5. Perform a Rotary Minute presentation. This can be one of the following:
 - a. One-minute presentation about yourself, your family, and your business
 - b. One-minute presentation something we should know about you, but don't.
 - c. Tell a joke suitable for our audience (there may be children present). It can be corny, but it must be funny.
 - d. If you have a talent display it. Play the piano, guitar, or ukulele, or sing us a tune. Better yet, lead the club in a sing along.
- 6. Assist the Sergeant-at-Arms with meeting set-up and break-down.
- 7. Invite a friend or business associate to attend a weekly meeting.

Once these conditions have been met, the Club President will remove your Red Ribbon from your badge during a weekly meeting.
