- 3) Lend a dollar—younger adults are start out in their careers and may not have the financial resources to pay Rotary dues; so let's try to be flexible.

When we lend an ear, lend a hand and lend a dollar, we're forming relationships that benefit the goals of Rotary and our Club. We gain perspective, energetic and creative members too. It's a win-win for all.

Anita O'Donnell is collecting feminine hygiene product for local social service agencies that help menstruating women and girls in need.


