

WHY DID YOU JOIN ROTARY?

Dr. Jeff Michelman, our District Governor, spoke to us on Wednesday. In addition to his comments on membership and service, Jeff told us that over \$15 million has been raised for helping the people of Ukraine by Rotary International. Additionally, our district 6970 has contributed over \$40k to the York Foundation for the people of the Ukraine. (The York Foundation is the District's nonprofit for fundraising.)

Jeff talked about how he became involved in Rotary and what Rotary has added to his life: he's built bathrooms in the South Pacific, participated in a grant that enabled someone to earn a Ph.D. in water sanitation, raised money to help eradicate Polio and visited India where he participated in giving polio vaccines. Jeff's description of seeing young people in India, pulling themselves along the ground due to paralysis from polio, created a strong mental picture. Polio is the Rotary's biggest project, and we can help through our donations and fundraising. Carolyn Mudgette mentioned that we will have a "dine out" in late October in conjunction with World Polio Day. The exact date will be announced as Marie Turnbull is coordinating the dine out at Raintree in St. Augustine. Jeff congratulated us for our participation in the Jaguars Polio fundraiser. He pointed out that approximately \$40 per ticket will go to the Rotary Polio Fund which is matched 2:1 by the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation. If you can't go to the game, consider buying a ticket for someone else—like a veteran since this game is the Military Appreciation Day game.
