NEXT RLI: February 18, 2017

What are the RLI courses? The RLI offers Rotary knowledge courses in three sessions.

Part 1 – "The Rotarian"
Emphasis is placed on providing an overview of Rotary programs and helping develop ideas that participants can take back to their Rotary Clubs. Courses include Object of Rotary, Rotary – The Bigger Picture, Membership Retention, Rotary Opportunities, Ethics & Vocational Service, and Rotary Foundation I.

Part II – "The Rotary Club"
Focus is placed on fostering the qualities of a knowledgeable Rotarian. The day includes an individual analysis of your Rotary Club and its effectiveness. Courses include *Analyzing*Your Rotary Club, Leadership – Team
Building, Strategic Planning, Service
Projects, and Public Relations.

Part III – "The Rotary Journey"
Understand what it means to be a Rotarian and how you can use your RLI knowledge to better your club. Courses include Rotary History, International Service, Leadership: Effective Strategies, Rotary Foundation II, Communication Techniques, and Making a Difference.


